Angela came to Fresh Start and it was her second time here. She had relapsed the first time, subsequently she became a Drug Court participant. She met with her case manager, Marla, regularly and worked on what would assist her in not relapsing. Employment afforded her time to build skills on her way to become self-sufficient. Angela had a dream, that dream was to use her cosmetology license to do hair. At the end of each case management meeting Marla would tell Angela to "spread her wings and fly!" Angela decided to apply for a stylist position and came home one day thrilled to report she had gotten the position to put her skills to use being a cosmetologist. Angela started her position and loved it. She was approved by Drug Court to move in with her grandmother and left our program successfully. Angela left Marla a note the day she moved out and it said keep on shining and "spread your wings and fly."

That seems odd to say, since I love what I do and miss seeing our team and residents. I have been working from home quite a bit over the past few months. This has been both to reduce people in the shelter and due to my family situation. I am so thankful that I have the opportunity to do so, and I recognize that many people do not have that option. Most of the staff at Fresh Start do not have that option, they are working in the shelter, still there and present for our residents. I am grateful for each person on our team that has shown up and continued our essential work to aid those experiencing homelessness.

I am grateful that I have a home from which I can work. I am grateful for the rambunctious child that occasionally is mugging for the camera during my video conference calls, happy that I have more time with her. I am so incredibly grateful that my family and friends are healthy and hope they continue to be. I am grateful that I have a computer and internet at home and can "Zoom" with family, more often than I usually see them! I am grateful that I have a vehicle and can do online ordering and curbside pickup to avoid crowds. Grateful that I have food in the cupboard and growing in the garden. I am grateful for the reminders of how good I have it. A good life. It's not one I take for granted.

I am NOT grateful for this pandemic. It has wreaked havoc in so many aspects of our lives. People are ill and dying. People's livelihood has been affected. Physical health and emotional wellbeing are at risk or compromised. It has had many negative impacts on Fresh Start as well. It has taken a toll on our residents, our team, and our programming. It has reduced revenue for Fresh Start through Daisy closures, event cancellations and more.

However, I am grateful for the reminders of the need to continue this work for others who are still working towards their "good life." Everyone deserves that, and I am honored to be on the path leading there for some. We cannot do it alone, and I am grateful that many of you are on that path with us. Inspiration and hope continue to be present within the Fresh Start walls, even in the midst of a global health crisis.

No, I am not grateful for the pandemic. While the effects of the pandemic are still unclear, one thing is certain. We at Fresh Start remain grateful for you.



The Daisy is reopening to the public on Thursday, August 27. Shopping will be by appointment only on Thursdays and Saturdays. Customers may sign up for 30 minute slots. Each time is limited to 2 people, in order to allow for social distancing within the shop, and people must sign up in advance. Masks are required.
