Growing Stronger

When Dawn (name has been changed) came to Fresh Start, she was very quiet and shy. You almost never heard a peep from her. We learned that she had not had positive experiences with her family or in her relationships. Dawn shared that she had been very anxious about coming to a shelter. She did not know what to expect. She was worried about what it would be like and if she would be able to get back on her feet. She didn't know if she would be accepted by others.

While at Fresh Start, Dawn learned that not everyone is judgmental or hurtful. Slowly she became more comfortable around staff and the other residents. Dawn began talking and laughing with others. She even would take new residents under her wing and help them get used to living in the shelter. She learned to accept her many strengths and abilities. She learned about the resources in the community that could help her address many of her needs. Dawn volunteered at a local agency, which also helped her self esteem and job related skills. Dawn found employment while at Fresh Start and began to save money. She now lives in her own apartment. Although she still struggles at times with her self esteem, Dawn also continues to grow stronger and now believes that she can be successful.

Dawn is one of the many women helped by Fresh Start each year. The longer stay that a transitional program like Fresh Start offers gave Dawn more time to address her needs while living in a safe place. Each woman's "story" is different, yet they all need a place to heal and stretch their wings. Fresh Start is that place.


